## TEREORA COLLEGE **CIFWA CLINIC SOON** TO COMMENCE

The CIFWA clinic at Tereora College is scheduled to commence from next week, Wednesday. CIFWA's Dean Kapi-Tangata said the days may shift for the time-being due to the HPV screening which takes place every Monday and Tuesday (at CIFWA), so the days will shift from Tuesday and Wednesday to Wednesday only, with possibility of adding Thursday. The clinic hours will run from 8am to 12 noon. The CIFWA clinic set up at Tereora College complements the counselling services by the school counsellor, and Dean is able to provide most of CIFWA's services family including planning, appointments for health checks, and his door is always open for questions, and assistance.
